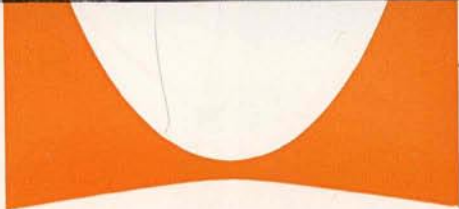

Charles Eames and George Nelson have designed for Herman Miller chairs which rock, swivel and tilt. They come in heights for writing and dining or reading and lounging.

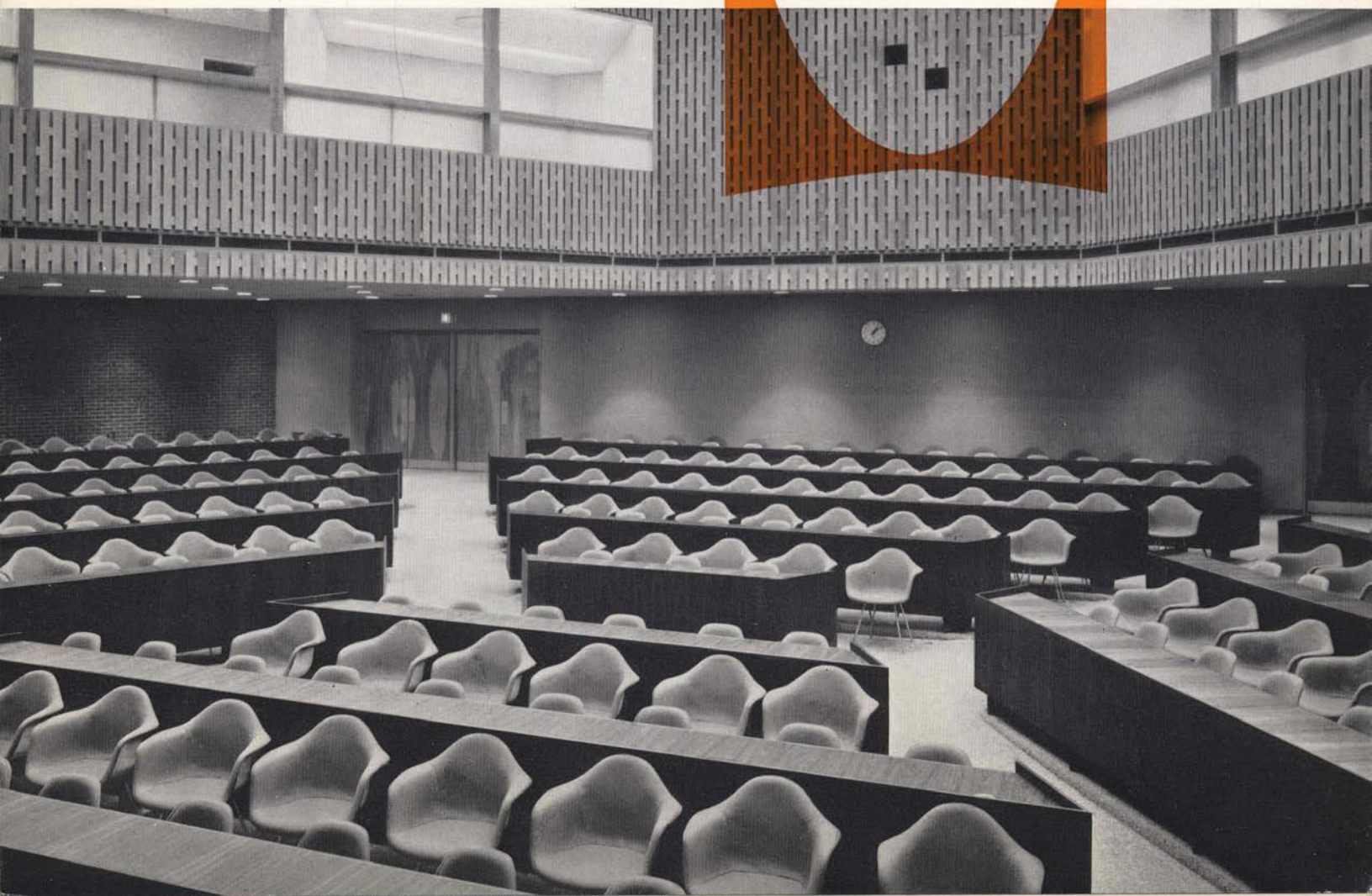
Materials used in these chairs are as varied and interesting as the shapes they help to create: plywood, welded wire and reinforced plastic — all function handsomely in these seating pieces.

INTERIORS magazine recently published a survey of chair designs of the past 100 years. This survey

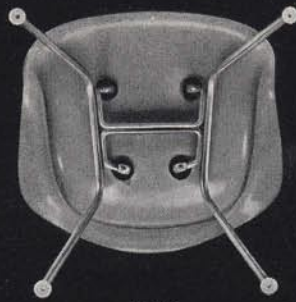

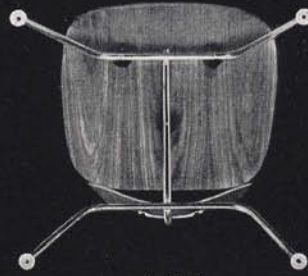

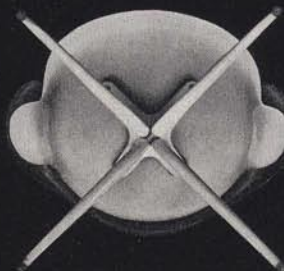
