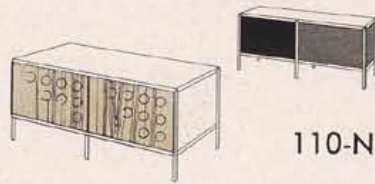
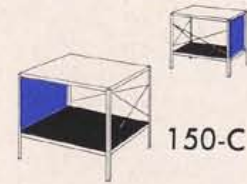
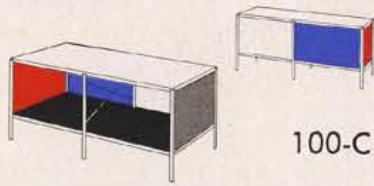


The storage units designed by Charles Eames represent a frank and forthright answer to a permanent and basic furniture need: attractive, durable cabinets, cases and desks that are modestly priced. Plated steel uprights support plastic-coated plywood shelves and stain resistant wood or plastic coated tops. Crossed metal struts or lacquered masonite panels insure stability. The units come in two widths—24" and 47"—and in three heights: 20", 32½" and 59½". All are 16" deep. There are numerous arrangements including open shelves, sliding panel doors and drawers, in a variety of color combinations. In its entirety, it is a fluid, comprehensive system that should answer most storage requirements. Illustrated here are all standard units of the 100, 200, and the 400 series of E.S.U. Cases, as well as the E.S.U. Desks. The various combinations available are shown in full color.

These units, being only 20" high, make a pleasing low divider in a room and will fit nicely under windows or for the child's room.

Behind the sliding doors is enclosed storage space that will take 12" albums—especially useful in a room scaled to low dimensions.

There are many uses for this small but versatile open storage unit which is 24 inches wide.



These are open shelves for open storage—the top shelf will accommodate a 10 inch record album, the bottom will take a 12 inch album.

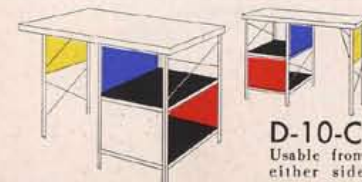
Of more enclosed construction but for open storage. These shelves hold books or records or the things that accumulate in a playroom.

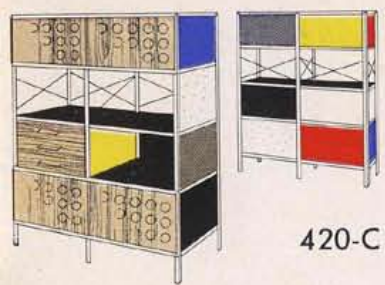
A three drawer section is in the upper left compartment, the rest of the space for open storage enclosed only by metal cross braces.

With the three drawer section are three open storage compartments, backed by a solid panel, perforated metal grille and metal cross brace.

Three drawers and open storage in two top compartments, the bottom two are enclosed, made accessible by a pair of sliding doors.

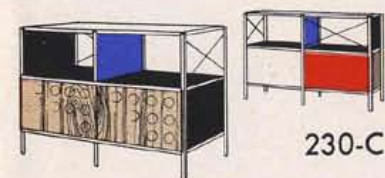

These units are 60 inch high and can be used as practical room dividers and in many places where plentiful storage space is required.

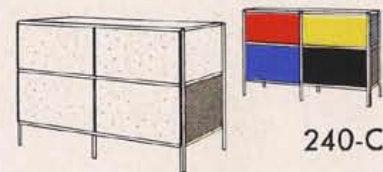
The height of the two top shelves are 11¼ and 13¼ inch respectively. The third shelf is 11¼ inch and the bottom shelf is 13¼ inch high.

Sliding doors cover eight lineal feet of storage space. There is also six lineal feet of open shelf and a set of three drawers.

These as well as all other E.S.U. pieces have the same high quality finish on all sides which makes them ideal for use free from wall.



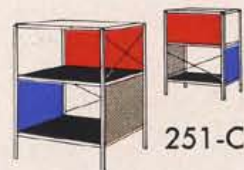

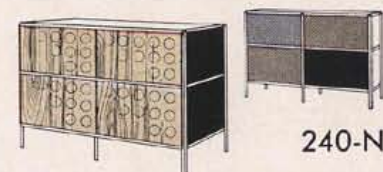

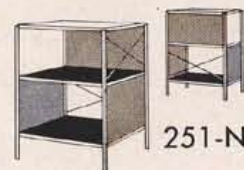

The top shelf is completely open, the bottom shelf is enclosed with solid panels and sliding doors to provide protected accessible space.

Back and side completely enclosed by solid panels. The entire front has sliding doors—enclosed space for linens, clothes or books.

24 in. versions of the open case serve by themselves and make the system dimensionally fluid.

Also an open storage unit, 24 inches wide, but sides and back have panels and cross braces.

A three drawer section above, open shelves below, cross braces and perforated metal grille.

Desks to the left have 44" x 24½" tops with open storage below for stationery and books. Ideal for the home and school dormitories.

Top dimension is 60" x 24½" and 29" in height. Additional uses for the E.S.U. desks as table for sewing or receptionist desk are suggested.

HOW TO ORDER—To place an order for an Eames Storage Unit, the following information is necessary:

type number example: 230-N

The chart shows the construction type of each unit. Indicate your choice by its code designation. Note that there is a neutral (N) or colorful (C) finish available in each construction type.

top finish example: BIRCH

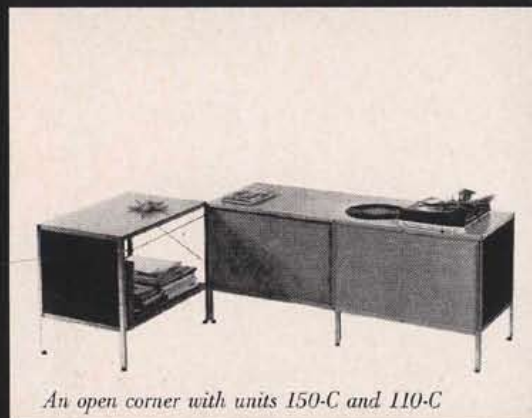
The top shelf is available in black plastic laminate, birch or walnut finish. The drawer fronts in each case will match the top shelf finish. Be sure to stipulate which you wish.

sliding doors example: DIMPLED

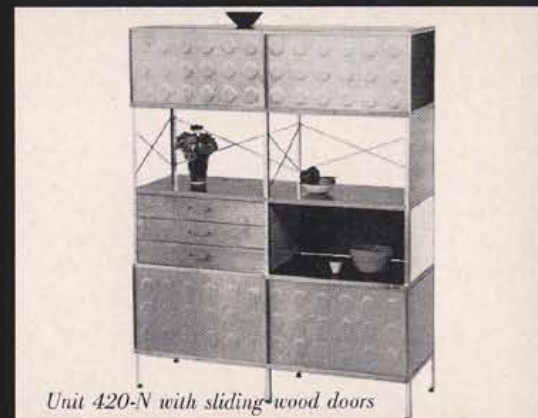
If the type you wish has sliding doors, these may be obtained in dimpled wood, white glass cloth laminate, or black plastic laminate. Again, note which you wish.

SAMPLE ORDER: 230-N-BIRCH-DIMPLED

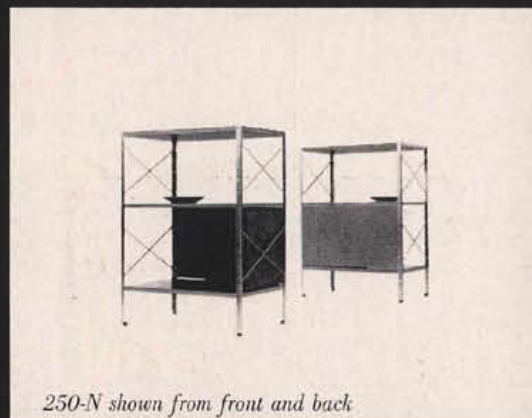
note: Specify right or left cabinet on D-20 orders. Each storage unit is shipped in a sturdy container, fully assembled and ready to use.



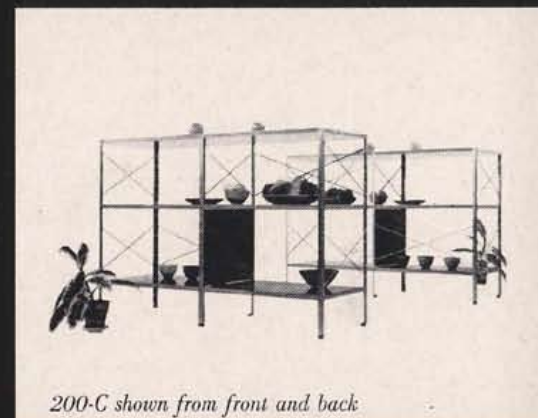
An open corner with units 150-C and 110-C

250-N shown from front and back



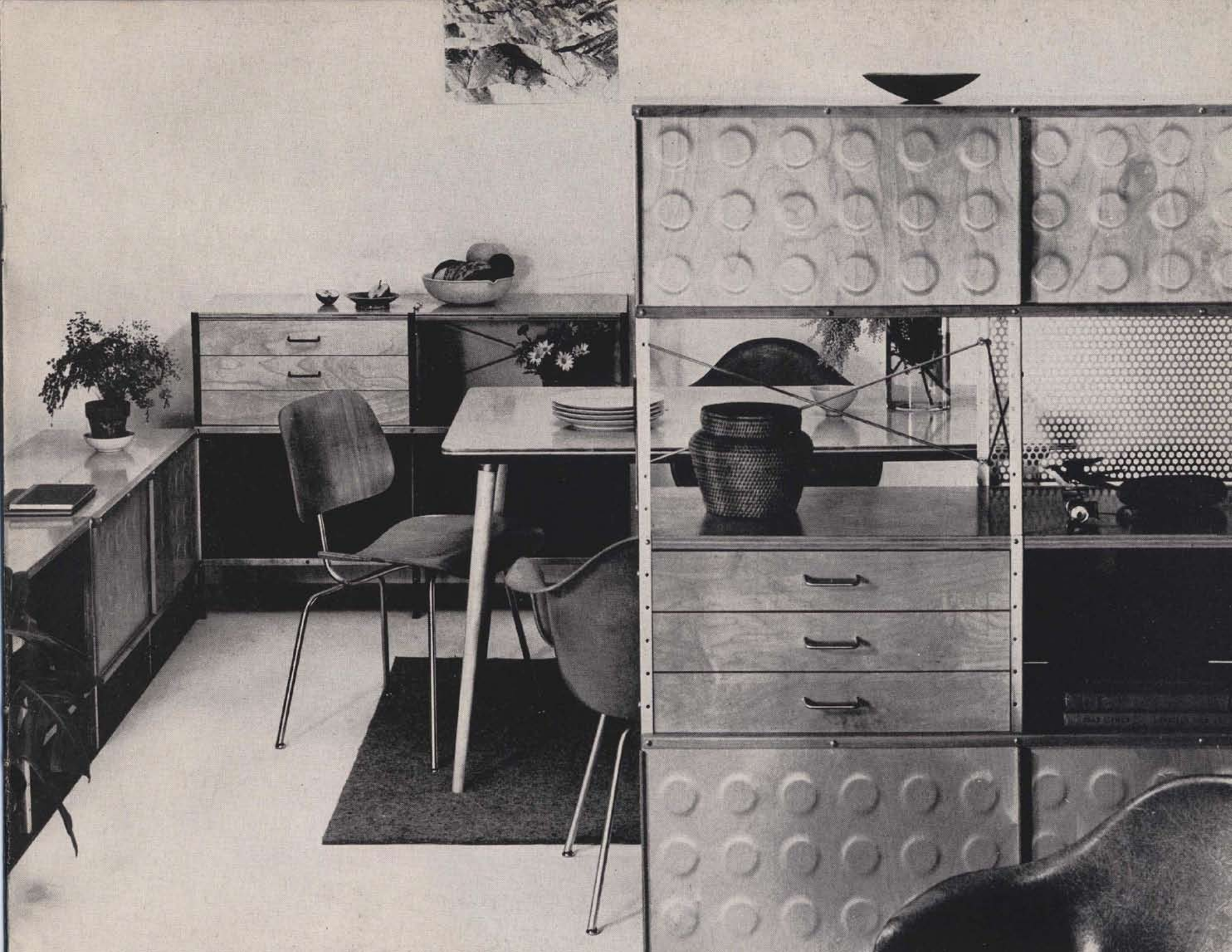
200-C shown from front and back
